- Design & Developed on Storyline Rise

- Exit survey provides insight into course effectiveness and learner satisfaction.

# RESULT

# **Needs Analysis Results**

- 94% of survey respondants said that they believe education for LGBTQ+ advocacy is important
- However, 47% were unsure of how to begin as an ally and LGBTQ+ advocate.

# **Course Evaluation Results**

- 66% of respondants rated themselves as very knowledgable about LGBTQ+ rights. before the course.
- 100% of participants rated themselves as very knowledgable after the course.

# CONCLUSION

This course leveraged data from a thorough needs analysis among 17 participants to determine that there is a need for LGBTQ+ allyship and advocacy education. Using a combination of an ADDIE framework and rapid design, I was able to create an informative, engaging, and effective e-learning course to impart actionable knowledge among an adult audience.
